### CHAPTER 17: The Period of Judges

**charism** special gift or grace given by God to a person for the good of others

**judges** temporary leaders of Israel who ruled from Joshua’s death until the beginning of the rule by the kings

**media** the Internet, podcasts, TV, newspapers, movies, comic books, magazines, CDs, tapes, videos, DVDs

**values** goals, ideals, or ideas we believe in or hold as important and worthwhile

### CHAPTER 18: The Kings of Israel

**chrism** blessed mixture of olive or vegetable oil and balsam or perfume used during Baptism, Confirmation, and the ordination of priests and bishops

**consecration** act of setting apart as holy or for God’s service

**David** second and greatest king of Israel, who united the tribes of Israel into one great nation

**ritual** the words and actions used in a religious ceremony

**Saul** first king of Israel, who was anointed by Samuel

### CHAPTER 19: David and Solomon

**Holy of Holies** the inner sanctuary of the Temple

**penitent** a person who is sorry for doing wrong

**proverb** wise saying; short statement that expresses truth

**repent** to be sorry, to make up for the wrong done, and to resolve not to do wrong again

**repentance** sorrow for doing something wrong and determination to make up for the wrong action and to avoid doing it again
