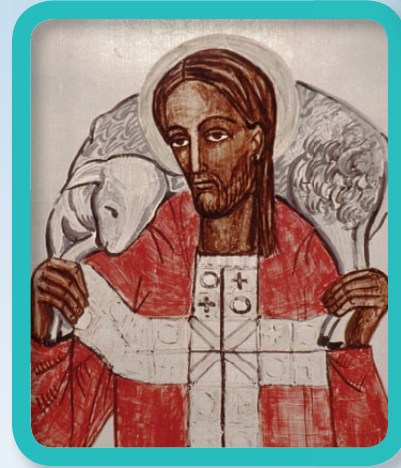


Faith Summary
