The Sacrament of Reconciliation

Keep these ideas in mind as you study Unit 3, Session 13.

Our sins are forgiven as the priest extends his hands over us and prays the prayer of absolution.

A priest keeps absolutely secret the sins confessed to him. This is called the seal of confession.

After we confess our sins, the priest gives us a penance. This is a prayer we pray or a deed we do to make up for our sins.

In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we are relieved of the burden of our sins. We feel joy in the freedom of forgiveness.

When we sin, we ask God and others for forgiveness.

Jesus forgave the sins of a man who was paralyzed. He healed the man so he could walk.
