1	1	Holy Trinity	The Trinity is the central mystery of our Christian faith and life.
	2	Baptism of Christ	John the Baptist announced the coming of Jesus, the promised Messiah.
	3	Exodus	Jesus fulfills the Revelation of God found in the history of the Chosen People.
	4	The Annunciation	Mary was the first person to say yes to Jesus and experience God's grace.
	5	Nourishment	Ordinary Time is a time to grow as a disciple of Christ.
2	6	Jesus and the Children	Jesus' loving example is the basis for the guiding principle of Catholic Social Teaching—the dignity of the human person.
	7	Comings and Goings	God and Jesus are present in all things.
	8	The Flight into Egypt	The hardships in Jesus' early life fulfilled prophecies and served as a reminder that the Savior came to save everyone.
	9	Jesus Found in the Temple	We can look to Jesus' experiences as we seek our own mission in life.
	10	Madonna and Child	We can trust the Lord completely to take away our fears and guide us in the right direction.
3	11	The Sower	Jesus accepted his mission as Messiah and renounced Satan's temptations. Jesus prepared us to hear God's Word by teaching the parable of the sower.
	12	The Palsied Man	Jesus' signs reveal that he is the one who fulfills the Father's promise to heal and save us.
	13	Jesus Teaching	In the Beatitudes, Jesus invites everyone to happiness in this life and eternal joy in the next.
	14	Little Girl Arise	Jesus offers everyone, regardless of status, his healing and Salvation.
	15	Jesus and Saint Peter	We imitate the life of Christ by living a life of humility and love.
4	16	The Last Supper	The Eucharist strengthens our connection to Jesus and God and also our connection as members of the Church.
	17	Margaret, Irish Girl	God gives us tools to help us discern the difference between right and wrong.
	18	Pietà	In our most painful and lowest moments, God shows us his true mercy.
	19	Through Him, With Him	We find and witness Christ's presence in the sacraments.
	20	Resurrection Morning	The mysteries surrounding Jesus' Passion, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension—the Paschal Mystery—are central to our faith .
5	21	Road to Emmaus	When we witness Jesus' true presence, we see the world in a new light.
	22	Music Lesson #2	God calls us to use the gifts he gives us to serve others and the Body of Christ.
	23	Saint Paul's Conversion	Like Saint Paul, God calls us to conversion. Saint Paul's words are meant for us just as they were for the early Christian communities.
	24	Our Lady of Guadalupe	Mary helps lead us to Salvation through Jesus Christ and shows us that God loves us all.
	25	Mary of Pentecost	The Church began with the sending of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. We serve the Kingdom of God when we use the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.

1	1	Keys of Saint Peter	We are called to follow Peter's example by proclaiming the Good News to others.
	2	Friends	Following the example of Church leaders, we are called to welcome all those who want to join the Church.
	3	Martyrs' Last Prayer	The early Christian martyrs were faithful to Jesus, even in the face of adversity.
	4	Confirmation	The Sacraments of Initiation welcome us into the community of believers known as the Church.
	5	Saint Joseph and Jesus	God desires to have a close relationship with each of us.
2	6	Trinity in Dark Tones	During the early ecumenical councils, Church leaders reflected on Jesus' relationship with God the Father. The fruit of their reflection is contained in the Nicene Creed, a prayer through which we profess our love and devotion to God.
	7	A Monstrance	Prayer, service to others, and sharing God's Word provide us spiritual nourishment and help free us to receive God's love and see his plan for us.
	8	Peasants in the Fields	Practicing the virtues of poverty, chastity, and obedience helps us follow Jesus' example and live peacefully with others.
	9	Ascension of Christ	The Holy Spirit guides us to live faith-filled lives and spread the Good News through our actions and words.
	10	Nativity Scene	As Catholics, we put our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and respect the New Covenant.
3	11	St. Francis at La Verna	By loving Jesus with all our hearts, just as Saint Francis did, we live a life marked by Jesus.
	12	St. Patrick's Cathedral	For generations, churches and cathedrals have served Catholics as places to gather as a community in our shared faith.
	13	The Last Supper	Participating in the celebration of the Eucharist unites us as members of the Body of Christ.
	14	Black Death	We care for people's physical and spiritual needs by following the example of the Church.
	15	Battle Scene	The Church provides us with a path to forgiveness through the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation.
4	16	God's Gift	By choosing to open our hearts to God, with our God-given free will, we open ourselves to God's restoration and gift of Salvation.
	17	The Good Samaritan	As disciples, we have a responsibility to love God and one another just as Jesus did.
	18	Saint Ignatius	We open our hearts to God so we can build a deep, loving relationship with him and find God in all things.
	19	Soup Kitchen in Paris	As Catholics, we are responsible to share God's love with those in need.
	20	Betrayal of Jesus	The Church celebrates Jesus' life, Passion, Death, and Resurrection during Holy Week and Easter so that we may be reminded of Jesus' sacrifice for our Salvation.
5	21	Second Vatican Council	In response to the needs of the modern world, the Church develops new ways to reach followers.
	22	Interior of a Mill	We build up the Kingdom of God by working to end injustices and by answering God's call to serve.
	23	Ceremony of Ordination	We respond to God's call to holiness by serving others and spreading God's grace.
	24	The Little Dancer	We respond to God's call by using our unique talents.
	25	Pentecost	Pentecost reminds us that as members of the Church, we support one another in fulfilling the Church's mission.
