1	1	An Illuminated Bible	Illuminated Bibles portray the importance of God's Word.
	2	Expelled from Paradise	The human family is created in the image and likeness of God.
	3	Building Noah's Ark	God made a covenant with Noah to never give up on people. We respond to God's covenant with our faith.
	4	Hora	God named Abraham and Sarah his Chosen People. Today, our faith makes us part of God's Chosen People.
	5	The Four Evangelists	The Evangelists wrote about different themes in Jesus' life.
2	6	Joseph, Son of Jacob	Through the examples set by Jesus and his ancestors, we see how our choices are part of God's plan.
	7	The Seder	Our modern faith practices have roots in ancient Jewish customs such as Passover.
	8	Michelangelo's Moses	Following the Ten Commandments helps improve our relationship with God.
	9	The Book of Ruth	Our choices, like Ruth's, have consequences that can affect our relationship with God.
	10	The Jesse Tree	The Jesse tree is a symbol of God fulfilling his promise to send the Messiah, Jesus.
3	11	Jesus with Soup	The Church is the new temple of the Holy Spirit.
	12	The Shepherd	Jacob's life as a shepherd can help us understand Jesus' life and relationship with us.
	13	Christ and Peter	Peter proclaimed Jesus as the Messiah who fulfilled the Old Testament prophecies.
	14	Paul Preaching	The Church is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic.
	15	Three Kings	The Magi were the first to acknowledge Jesus as King.
4	16	The Prophet Jeremiah	The prophets who called the Chosen People to repentance and conversion were powerful witnesses to God.
	17	Isaiah	The Old Testament prophets offered hope and encouragement to the people of their times.
	18	Peter, the Keystone	Jesus is the cornerstone of the Church.
	19	Two Blind Men Cured	In celebrating the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick, we find the healing presence of God in our everyday lives.
	20	Nocturne (Gethsemane)	The Church celebrates Lent and Holy Week.
5	21	Thérèse of Lisieux	Jesus calls us to practice the virtues of faith, hope, and charity.
	22	The Wedding at Cana	In the Sacrament of Matrimony, Christians are called to holiness.
	23	Homage to Csontváry	All of creation is a gift from God, and the goods of the earth are to be used in ways that honor God.
	24	Saint Patrick	As Christians, we are called to support the common good and the fundamental rights of each person.
	25	God Gives	The Church celebrates Easter.
